Each mailing must be delivered to an agreed Jersey Post Group site no later than an agreed latest acceptance time (LAT) on day of posting accompanied with completed electronic postage docket and full line listing as required. Minimums are defined by aggregated annual forecast. Subject to mail profile a client posting two million or more items per year from any one site may be provided with a container on site to facilitate transport of mail. It is the client's responsibility to load this container.
Level of sortation	Full postcode sorted and presented on pallets (as agreed). See Note 6 below

Note 6	Due to the seasonal nature of perishable products dispatched on pallets it is accepted (with prior agreement with Jersey Post Group) that during "shoulder" dispatches that minimum volumes may not be met in full. Jersey post Group may require this mail to be presented in an alternative form of containment (for example a Rigid Stackable Container).

Jersey Post Group takes no responsibility for tracking, tracing or claiming compensation of missing items and does not offer compensation on "Signed for bulk items. Compensation is available on "Special Delivery Bulk" items. An electronic record of "Signed For" Bulk numbers against delivery names and addresses must be kept and made available to Jersey Post Group as required for revenue protection purposes.
