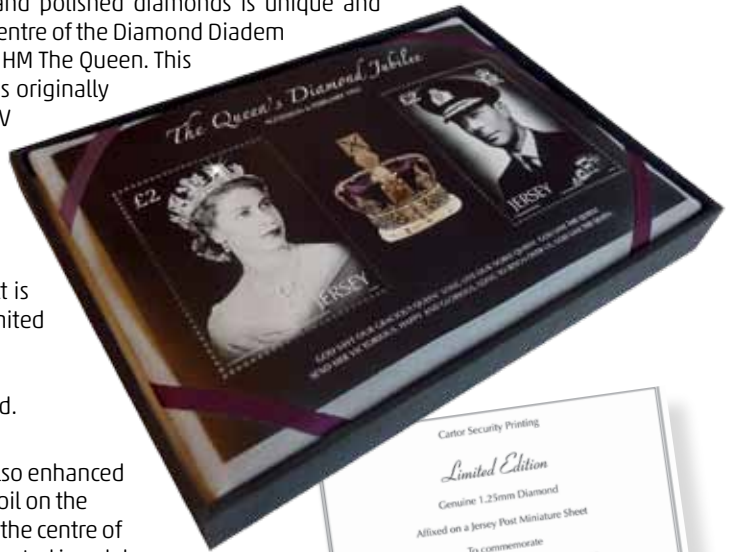

This aptly named crown was originally created for George IV and was worn by Her Majesty during the procession to her Coronation in 1953.

This special product is also enhanced by embossing and hot foil on the Imperial State Crown at the centre of the sheet. Although the stamps within the Souvenir Miniature Sheets are separate, the sheets of four stamps present the two se-tenant pairs in all their glory. When King George V died in 1936, his eldest son acceded to the throne as King Edward VIII and the young Princess' future began to unfold. At the time, with her uncle as King, Princess Elizabeth was second in line of succession after her father and was not expected to become Queen. However, King Edward VIII famously announced that he could not continue without the woman he loved at his side and The Duke of York and Princess Elizabeth's destinies were realigned.

Upon the abdication, The Duke of York became King George VI and Elizabeth, heiress to the throne. The portraits were specifically chosen so that HM The Queen and King George VI would be facing each other. It is well documented that the family was close and this tender composition suggests a daughter's love and respect for her father.

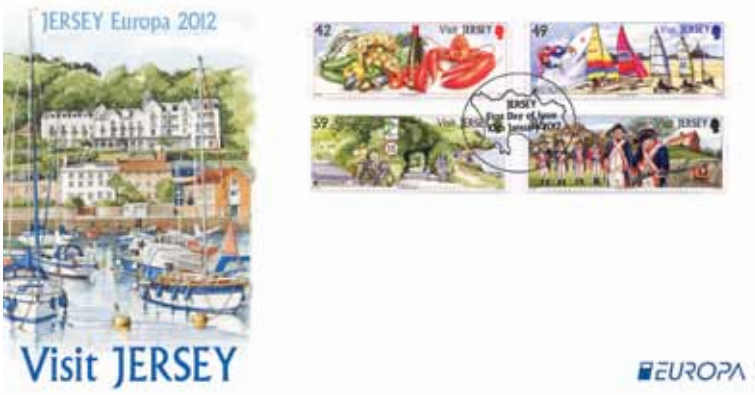

The National Trust for Jersey was founded in 1936 to protect and safeguard historic buildings and sites as well as the environment. Today the charity is the largest private landowner in the Island caring for over 160 sites.

These delightful stamps feature wildlife in local scenes to celebrate the Trust's outstanding achievements in conservation.

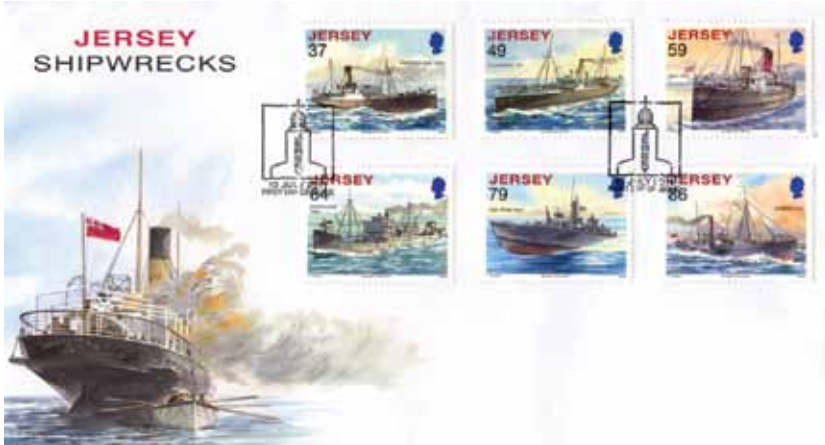
